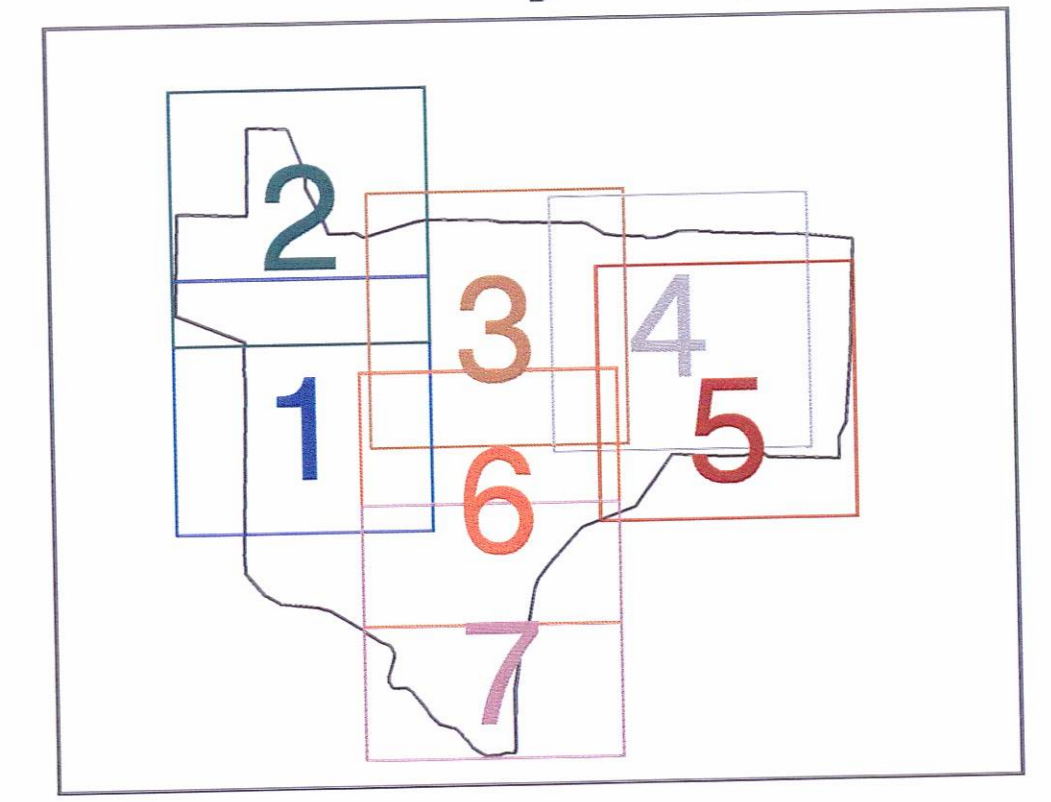

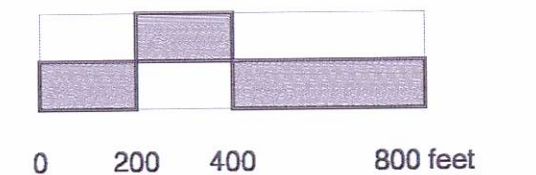
Vicinity Map

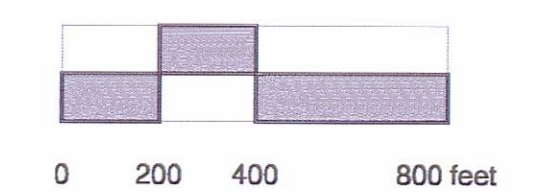
Vicinity Map
